This spectacular event begins with tea and coffee served in the Guildhall Club Members' Bar at 9.30 a.m. and at 10.00 a.m. we will make our way down to Guildhall Yard to see the Lord Mayor's coach being prepared and harnessed to six shire horses. After waving off the coach you are free to watch the procession, unlike any other in the world: last year there were over 7000 participants, 20 bands and 150 horses. We will then make our way to the Guildhall Club Members' Dining Room for a sumptuous 4-course lunch commencing with welcome drinks at 12.15 p.m.
