**Water, Water Everywhere – a guided walk in Hyde Park
followed by Afternoon Tea at
The Royal Thames Yacht Club - Knightsbridge**

Walk starts at 2.15pm from The Italian Gardens accessed through the Marlborough Gates immediately opposite Lancaster Gate u/g station (Central Line)



Our guide, Nick Lane, will take us on a gentle amble through Hyde Park to explain the mysteries of water in this environment - taking about 1 ½ hours and ending at the east end of the Serpentine



After our walk we will make our way (five minutes) to The Royal Thames Yacht Club in Knightsbridge to take afternoon tea in the Mountbatten Suite overlooking the Park.
