

### St Alphage High Walk

In this garden you will find the bronze of the 'Minotaur' by Michael Ayrton. From here you can see some of the private gardens of the residents of the Barbican. Private gardens are very rare in the City. Common and encouraged on this estate are window boxes – there is the capacity here to house around 12 miles (20km) of them!



From here you can see some of the City's wonderful modern architecture 30 St Mary Axe; 'The Gherkin', Tower 42 (former NatWest Tower) and 1 Coleman Street.
