A Tour of the Government Art Collection

with Supper at 'Steak & Lobster'.

WEDNESDAY 23rd NOVEMBER 2016



This is a visit to a building in Queen's Yard, just off Tottenham Court Road, which is home to the UK Government's Art Collection or, more accurately, the part of it that is not currently adorning the walls of government buildings, embassies, and official residences throughout the world.

We will see a selection of works from the Collection which includes a mixture of traditional and modern pieces - portraiture, landscape and abstract.

We'll hear about the GAC's history and its role, and get a behind-the-scenes look at works as they are prepared for display. Our tour will also include the conservation workshop and with paintings regularly 'on the move' we'll discover some of the activities necessary to protect the artworks during shipping and how they conserve for differing climates. The tour will last about an hour and there will be plenty of time to ask questions. Photography is allowed.

Queen's Yard is a small alleyway off Tottenham Court Road (just opposite Howland Street), in-between two shops: "Cards Galore" and "Dreams, Bed Specialist". Go down the alley and about 25yards on the right hand side the GAC entrance is through a pair of large black doors. Your name will be with the Security Guard and we will all meet on the 4th Floor.

After what promises to be a fascinating and unusual visit, we'll walk just 3 minutes up the road to 'Steak & Lobster' in Warren Street for a glass or two of wine and an informal two course supper. As the name suggests, the food options here are either Steak or (wait for it) Lobster. Please make your selections on the Booking Form.
