Evening Tour of Cutlers Hall, Warwick Lane, London EC4M 7BR

This is another evening event starting at 6.30 p.m. We will be welcomed by the Beadle who will take us on a tour of the Hall and explain some of the history not only of the Hall but the origins of the Cutlers themselves. The Cutlers Company is one of the oldest livery companies in the City of London and received its Royal Charter in the reign of Henry V, though Cutlers are known to have been practising their craft in London since at least the second or third century AD. The two-hour Hall tour includes tea / coffee with biscuits on arrival as well as a Cutlers history booklet. Following the tour, we will partake of nibbles with either a glass of wine or a soft drink.

The nearest underground station is St. Paul's, a five to ten-minute walk from the Hall.
